PURPOSE

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and your rights concerning cookie usage.

DEFINITION

1. IP Address: A unique string of characters that identifies each computer using the Internet Protocol to communicate over a network.
2. Cookie: Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile) when you visit a website.
3. Browser: A browser is a software program that locates and displays information on the Internet or an intranet.
4. Persistent cookies: Cookies that remain on a user’s device even after they close their browser.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, or mobile) when you visit a website. Cookies enable the website to recognize your device, remember your preferences, and provide relevant functionality.

Cookies can be classified as:

1. Session Cookies: Temporary cookies that are deleted when you close your browser.
2. Persistent Cookies: Cookies that remain on your device for a specified period or until manually deleted.
3. First-Party Cookies: Set by the website you are visiting.
4. Third-Party Cookies: Set by external services integrated into the website.

TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use the following types of cookies:

1. Strictly Necessary Cookies: These cookies are essential for the website to function correctly. They enable core functionalities such as security, network management, and accessibility. You cannot turn off these cookies through our cookie consent tool.

2. **Performance and Analytics Cookies:** These cookies help us understand how users interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously.
3. **Functional Cookies:** Functional cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalization, such as remembering your preferences (e.g., language or region).
4. **Advertising and Targeting Cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver personalized advertisements and track the effectiveness of marketing campaigns. We may set them as third-party advertising partners.

HOW WE USE COOKIES

We use cookies to:

1. Provide essential website functionality.
2. Enhance user experience and website performance.
3. Analyze website traffic and usage patterns.
4. Deliver relevant advertising and content.
5. Enable integrations with third-party services (e.g., social media, analytics tools).

2. **Legitimate Interest:** For strictly necessary cookies required for website functionality and security.
